"It is a governed Agent Center built on two foundations: structured, certified business data – numbers the organization can trust – and built-in knowledge of how enterprise processes actually work. On top of this, domain-specific agents reason and act within trusted processes. Akyba is also LLM-agnostic – companies use their own AI models, from GPT to Claude, without vendor lock-in, while keeping full control over data, policies and costs. They can customize agents to their needs and scale them across the platforms they already use."*

Akyba is being introduced to the market through the **Akyba Pioneer Program**, a selected group of global enterprises working with Akeron to deploy, measure and refine Akyba in production environments. Current pioneers include **Euroansa, OptimizeRx, DS Tech and Creatives**, representing different industries and use cases across the Akeron platform suite.

*"According to Gartner, by 2026 more than 40% of enterprise applications will embed task-specific AI agents, up from less than 5% just a year ago. The question is no longer whether to adopt AI, but where and how to integrate it reliably," said **Manuel Vellutini, Co-CEO of Akeron**. "That's exactly what the Pioneer Program is for. Our pioneers – companies like OptimizeRx and Euroansa – are already experiencing the shift: from using the Akeron platform for daily operations to leveraging it for strategic analysis and faster decisions. This is the real change: humans and AI agents working together, turning insights into concrete actions that improve business results. Akyba gives organizations the missing link between analyzing performance and actually improving it. Our pioneers want to be at the forefront of this new era – and they are co-designing it with us."*
